## **Professor Tom Arie**

Professor Tom Arie is one of the founding fathers of old age psychiatry. He established a unit for older people at Goodmayes Hospital in London in 1969. In 1977, he moved on as Foundation Professor of Health Care of the Elderly at Nottingham University and he is now Professor Emeritus. He was the Chair of the then Section for the Psychiatry of Old Age and is an Honorary Fellow of the Royal College of Psychiatrists. His seminal publications shaped UK old age psychiatry services and he has lectured and advised in many countries.
