Invited speakers:

Professor Robin Jacoby DM, FRCP, FRCPsych.



Professor Robin Jacoby is a world-famous psychiatrist in the profession. He studied modern languages (Russian & French) at Oxford, followed by medicine at Oxford and Guy's Hospital. He undertook postgraduate training in internal medicine at Southampton University Hospitals and psychiatric training at the Bethlem Royal and Maudsley Hospitals, where he was also a consultant for ten years before moving to Oxford in 1994. Currently he is Professor Emeritus of Old Age Psychiatry at the University of Oxford. He has published original research in the field of dementia and depression in old age. With Drs Catherine Oppenheimer, Tom Dening and Alan Thomas he edits *The Oxford Textbook of Old Age Psychiatry* now in its 4th edition (2008). He is an expert in testamentary capacity, and has remarkable experience in contentious probate cases. He gave evidence in the Hong Kong High Court in 2009 in the case of *Chinachem-v-Chan*. Dr. Cheung Hung-kin is one of the iconic psychiatrists in Hong Kong. As a former forensic psychiatrist in charge of Siu Lam Psychiatric Centre and the Medical Superintendent of Castle Peak hospital, his contribution in the development of the Mental Health Ordinance in Hong Kong, and his expertise in forensic psychiatry are well-recognized in the profession. Dr. Cheung is currently a psychiatric specialist in private practice, and an Honorary Clinical Associate Professor of the University of Hong Kong. Dr. Cheung is going to talk on "A few interesting local case reports to illustrate testamentary & contractual capacity".

Dr. Victor Lui FHKCPsych, FHKAM(Psych)



Dr. Victor Lui is an Associate Consultant of the Department of Psychiatry, Tai Po Hospital. He is a fellow of the Hong Kong College of Psychiatrists, and a member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists. Dr. Lui holds a Bachelor's degree of Laws at the University of London and is a board member of the local Guardianship Board. His research focuses on medico-legal issues for persons with dementia. He has investigated issues in informed consent, treatment decision-making, and decision-making in everyday life. He is going to talk on "Structured assessment of mental capacity: from making treatment decision to making a will".
